Dear Parents/Carers,

As the weather is changeable at the moment, please make sure the children have suitable clothing with them.

When hot we do encourage children to take off their jumpers. However, the children find it very hard to identify their jumper out of 26 other similar blue school jumpers. If your child brings home another child's jumper, please return it to the nursery staff and we will return it to the correct child. With this in mind, please check your child's jumpers and make sure they are clearly labelled with their names.

We always have water available for the children and on hot days we encourage children to have extra drinks. This means the children should not bring in their own drink bottles. Drinks with Unibear lunches are permitted.

As the weather gets warmer please ensure sun cream is applied *before* coming to nursery. Please do not leave this in bags.

We have children in nursery with food allergies and kindly ask that, for the safety of other children, your child does not arrive at nursery eating food, or have any food of any kind in any of their bags or pockets. The exception is for Unibear children who have lunch with us, and whose food bags are stored safely out of reach during the day.

After half term we hope to have regular 'Forest fun' sessions. In the next few weeks, the children will be visiting this area in smaller groups to help them become familiar with it. A letter with more details will be sent home shortly.

Please can your child **NOT** bring in any toys from home, unless already agreed with the teacher.

If you have any spare plastic scoops, like the ones that come with stain remover or baby milk, please could we have them in Nursery. Any old wellies that your children have outgrown would also be gratefully received.

Can we also remind everyone that, in line with school policy, children should be absent for 48 hours *after* the last bout of sickness or diarrhoea. Thank you to all those that already follow this guidance.
