Nursery Newsletter – Summer Term 2023

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back after Easter.

Our focus this term: We will continue with our letter a week and number work. We will be sharing 'Goldilocks and the three bears', we will share 'The very hungry caterpillar' story and stories about frogs and tadpoles. Like the rest of the school, we will be talking about I can do this and follow my dreams! In nursery, this will be thinking about dressing ourselves, going to the toilet, putting on a sun hat in the sun, removing our own coat when we feel too hot. We will also be thinking about different jobs people do.

Staffing news: This term we welcome Miss Curtis, a Nursery teacher, who will be working Thursday and Friday. Mrs Corris will continue to work Monday to Thursday. We said goodbye to Mrs Lilo and we will be soon be saying a hello to Mrs Barret, an early years learning support assistant, who will be working across Nursery and Reception classes. Mrs Smith, Miss Slack and Mrs Price continue to work in Nursery.

Independence and self-care: Please support your child in becoming more independent in self-care when using the toilet and removing and putting on their shoes.

Clothing: Please remember to name your children's clothes especially as the weather changes and they will be taking items of clothing off!

Please can the children come into Nursery with weather appropriate clothes e.g. if cloudy and cool, the children will need coat or an extra jumper. If hot, they will need sun cream applied **before** coming to nursery. Sun cream should **not** be brought in or left in children's bags. The children will be told to wear sun hats in the sunny weather. We have a large box of hats that the children can use while in nursery. They are welcome to bring their own, but please make sure they are labelled. If your child comes home with a hat that is not theirs, please can it be returned to nursery so we can find it's rightful owner.

Missing Toys: We are finding that an extreme amount of toys have gone missing from Nursery. Please can you check your child's bags and pockets for toys that could be ours. If you have any that have come home from last term, please can they be returned. We understand that young child do tend to want to take things, but we are trying to teach the children that things at nursery stay at nursery and things at home stay at home.
