

Daily Routine

The routine can vary according to the needs of the children. Children feel secure in familiar routines and having a basic structure helps children to know what is happening e.g. arriving → playing → having snack → group time → tidying up → going home.

How my child will be learning

The EYFS Framework explains how and what your child will be learning to support their healthy development.

Through play your child will be learning skills, acquiring new knowledge and demonstrating their understanding through **7 areas of learning and development.**

Children should mostly develop the **3 prime areas** first. These are:

Communication and language;
Physical development; and
Personal, social and emotional development.
These prime areas are those most essential for your child's healthy development and future learning.

As children grow, the prime areas will help them to develop skills in **4 specific areas.**

These are:
Literacy;
Mathematics;
Understanding the world; and
Expressive arts and design

The children are offered a fruit/vegetable snack during each session. Snack also includes a choice of milk or water to drink. If your child has any dietary requirements or allergies please ensure Nursery staff are aware.

Children attending full days will need to provide their own packed lunch, which should be a balanced meal containing no nuts and seeds for allergen reasons. Lunch boxes will be stored safely.

Please do not send any food, drink or medication in your children's bags. Please have a conversation with Nursery staff if there is a need for these items to be in Nursery.
