



English

We will focus on "The Great Pet Sale" by Mick Inkpen. Children will continue to work on punctuating sentences with full stops and exclamation marks and will develop their writing further by using plurals, prefixes, suffixes and different adjectives.

In phonics we will continue to re-visit the sounds taught and consolidate learning by applying them to our reading and writing, in readiness for Year 2.

PSHE

The focus will be money and work, we will start by exploring how everyone has different strengths in and out of school. Children will learn that these strengths and interests are needed to do different jobs.

We will learn about people whose job it is to help us in the community.

Focus Subject: Design Technology

Our focus will be Food and where our foods come from. Children will think about the "farm to fork" journey, and use this idea to design, make and evaluate a "pizza".

Maths

In Maths our focus will be on Place Value to 100, Money and Time. We will continue to practice our problem solving and reasoning ideas, and become fluent and automatic in our mental recall of number facts and ways to solve number problems.

Year 1

Summer Term: Part 2 Creativity and Individuality

Focus Subject: Art

Children will revisit the elements of line, shape and colour, and then start to introduce the element of texture through mark making, collage and printing.

Our school Summer Carnival will give the children experiences of textiles as they prepare flags and displays to showcase to their parents.

Science

The topic is 'Animals including Humans: All about animals.' Children will learn the animal families; reptiles, mammals, birds, amphibians and fish. They will think about the differences between these groups and classify animals according to their animal family.

We will think about the types of food that living things eat and learn the difference between wild animals and pets. Children will identify and classify animals according to their characteristics.

Religious Education

We will continue to think about the question, 'How did the universe come to be?'

We will focus on the world around us, and how we are instrumental in it.

Children will find out about other people who have lived before or who are alive now, and the impact they have had on the wider world.

Physical Education

Invasion Games: Children will begin to understand the role of defenders and attackers through playing simple games in pairs and small groups. They will learn to recognise who to pass to and why. They will explore how to support a teammate when playing in attack and how to stay with a player when defending.
