It has been a very warm week at Montgomery Infant School and the children have enjoyed a range of indoor and outdoor activities using our wonderful outdoor space, including our Forest School area and school field. Whilst the warm weather remains in the forecast, please continue to ensure children are protected from the hot sunshine. Thank you for your support with this.





Reception enjoyed their Road Safety session on Monday 16th June with the Essex Safer Roads team. It was great to have parents attend the sessions too. The children learned that they need to 'Stop, Look, Listen and Think' when crossing all roads. Thank you to our reception parents for coming along to support your child.

On Wednesday, to the children's delight we celebrated National Picnic Day with a sandwich lunch in the school hall. The children brought along their cuddly toy and enjoyed eating lunch alongside them. It was a really fun lunchtime for us all. Thank you to our servery staff and Junior School catering team for preparing the food.



On Thursday 26th June, Years 1 and 2 will be taking part in 'Joy of Moving' workshops, run by Colchester United. These sessions highlight the importance of exercise in helping us remain healthy both physically and emotionally.

Looking forward, next week we are holding our Year 2 Induction morning on Tuesday 24th June at 10am. Parents of our current Year 2 children will have the chance to learn more about life in the Juniors, meet the Year 3 teachers and have a tour of the school. Please ensure all paperwork from the Induction packs is returned promptly if you have a child who is on our Y3 admissions list, which is currently full.



Most of our nursery visits have now taken place and we are currently full with a waiting list. Details of your child's transition arrangements are being sent home ready for their September start. Thank you to Mrs Corris and Miss Hennings for organising the administration for our new nursery children.

On Wednesday 25th June, the parents of our new Reception intake (September 2025) are invited to join us for their child's Induction visit at 2:30pm. During this session, the children will meet their teachers whilst the parents learn more about life in a Reception class. We look forward to meeting our new Reception cohort next week.

Our whole school transition day is Wednesday 2nd July: the children will meet their new teachers and visit their new classrooms ready for September. The Year 3 team are looking forward to meeting the new Y2 children who will be transitioning to the Juniors. This is the final time there will be a Y2 Induction, as in future, due to the amalgamation, no admissions applications will be required between Year 2 and Year 3.

From September, parents will be asked to download the Parentpay app to book school clubs and make payments for trips and visits. We will provide further details once the technical aspects of the amalgamation have been carried out.

We will no longer be subscribing to Tapestry for our Year 1 and 2 children from September 2025; we will continue to use Tapestry for our EYFS children. The KS1 (Year 1 and 2) children's learning will be recorded in books next academic year, which will be sent home for parents to keep. These will include photographic evidence. Please ensure you download any photographs you wish to keep by Friday 11th July. After this date, they will not be available.

For the final two weeks of term, a joint Montgomery Primary newsletter will be sent home to parents across both schools. We hope that you enjoy learning more about what is going on with the older children and vice versa. Thank you for your support with this.
